### EMS

There were 21 Medic runs and 4 fire runs during the months of January and February. Illnesses and injuries as part of household accidents dominated the runs. There were 3 responses for Motor Vehicle crashes.  
In March there were 11 Medic runs and 4 Fire runs. The average response time was 8 minutes from time of dispatch to time on scene.

The cost of EMS and Fire Services are \$77,875.00 per quarter. The last quarter is adjusted as needed. This pays for wages, Social Security, Public Employees Retirement System, Medicare, FICA, administrative city, solicitor, officers, disability, training, physicals, uniforms, paging, pager services, medical supplies, communications, software, support, and membership.

The Village of Casstown has an EMS Contract with Elizabeth Township. It is for 3 years. They pay the township \$1,000.00 per year for the service.
