Elizabeth Township Farmland Preservation

The Ohio Department of Agriculture, Office of Farmland Preservation has finished the preliminary results for the 2008 Ohio AEPP program. There were almost 200 applications from 30 counties that applied for the \$3.125 million available in this program. The guidelines that were adopted by Director Boggs for the dispersal of the funds were (1) there was to be regional balance according to the 2008 quadrant map and (2) a limit of one funded property per county. Elizabeth Township had seven applications from six individuals apply for the 2008 program and all six of these individuals are now eligible for the local Elizabeth Township Farmland Preservation Program. The local program provides Elizabeth Township land owners who receive a ranking from the AEPP program an opportunity to receive up to \$1000.00 per acre to preserve their farmland under a preservation easement. The Township provides up to \$1,000,000 annually to be used for this program to preserve our farmland for future generations.
